In 2014, as a Member of Congress, I began the Parliamentary Intelligence-Security Forum to develop a better working knowledge and stronger collaboration with global Parliamentarians on critical security and technology issues. In most countries, Parliamentarians write the policies and legislation and prioritize government funding to address revolving technologies affecting national security.

Over 150 experts from industry, government and think tanks have participated in 17 conferences, hosted by Speakers of Parliaments around the world and over a dozen webinars. Over 10,000 Parliamentarians from 120 countries have participated in these fora and webinars.

Our objective is to raise the level of understanding of critical security issues, including illicit finance practices, 5G, Artificial Intelligence, Cybersecurity, Blockchain, Quantum Computing, Foreign Investments, Human Trafficking, Trade-Based Money Laundering, and the like. This year, we plan to host additional events in Panama, Budapest, Jerusalem, Washington, Asia, and Africa.
